

Kilmore and District Adult Riding Club Every Member Is A Winner Award

About The Award And How To Enter

The K&DARC Every Member Is A Winner Award is awarded to members in recognition of their dedication and support of the Club as well as improving themselves mounted/ unmounted over the HRCV membership year at the club. (1st October to 30th September of each year).

Members will be responsible for completing their logs (on the club issued forms) and getting them signed by either the Secretary/ Assistant Secretary throughout the membership year. Members, who are requesting points for competition participation, will also need to provide photocopies of their performance cards for the relevant disciplines.

All completed logs will need to be submitted to the Secretary by no later than 30th September each year. The completed forms can either be mailed to PO Box 446, Kilmore Vic 3764 or alternatively scanned and emailed to secretary@kadarc.org






Please Note late entries received after 30th September will be unable to be accepted.







Criteria

To be eligible for the award, the nominee must be a financial member of K&DARC and complete the official club log forms and get the log signed as per instructions.



In addition to the point system, members should be a fair, honest member who has contributed to better themselves and the good of the club. The award is not just about skill level but in recognition of the member's contribution to the Kilmore and District Adult Riding Club as a whole.

Contributions and Points Awarded

-  Club Committee Member – 25 points.
-  Attendance at Rallies (mounted/ unmounted). *Members must stay for at least 50% of the rally and assist on the day in some capacity eg setting up/ packing up jumps, assisting with the BBQ lunch etc. Please make sure you get your log signed at the rally – 10 points.*
-  Attendance at the club's monthly meeting – 5 points.
-  Helper in some capacity with the organisation of the club's social events – 15 points.
-  Attendance at the Club's Annual Working Bee – 15 points.






-  Volunteer helper at the Club's HRCav Kilmore Show Ring at the Annual Kilmore Show – 15 points.
-  Volunteer helper at HRCav events including TTT events. 10 points.
-  Volunteer helper to K&DARC riders competing at HRCav competitions - 10 points. *Log will need to be signed by a riding club member competing.*
-  Attendance at a clinic – 5 points
-  Representing K&DARC at HRCav events –5 points for participating, a bonus of 10 points for a win and 5 points for a place. *Log will need to be signed by a club member attending other than rider or by a member of the event office.*
-  Representing K&DARC at Top Teams Trophies – 10 points for participating with a bonus of 10 points for a team win and 5 points for a team place. *Log will need to be signed by a club member attending other than rider or by a member of the event office.*

Please Note

-  If you receive payment for attending a HRCav competition ie: judging, course building etc, no points will be awarded towards the Every Member Is A Winner Award.
-  To be eligible for an award, a minimum of four rallies must be attended either mounted or unmounted.

What Do The Points All Mean

Once the members points are calculated special recognition will be awarded to those members that reach the below milestones.

-  Reach a minimum of 150 points – Roll of Merit
-  Reach a minimum of 300 points – Bronze Award
-  Reach a minimum of 500 points – Silver Award
-  Reach a minimum of 750 points – Gold Award
-  Reach a minimum of 1500 points – Platinum Award

The special recognition of member's milestones will take place at the club's Annual General Meeting traditionally held in October every year.
